## **CDBG**

• For every one dollar (\$1.00) of CDBG funding another \$11.68 in private and public funding was leveraged for the 2005-2006 fiscal year.

For every one dollar (\$1.00) of CDBG funding another \$24.04 in private and public funding was leveraged for the 2006-2007 fiscal year.

For every one dollar (\$1.00) of CDBG funding another \$43.60 in private and public funding was leveraged for the 2007-2008 fiscal year.

For every one dollar (\$1.00) of CDBG funding another \$41.35 in private and public funding was leveraged for the 2008-2009 fiscal year.

For every one dollar (\$1.00) of CDBG funding another \$15.13 in private and public funding was leveraged for the 2009-2010 fiscal year.

- 37,746 persons, 26 households, 1,087 housing units, 18 public facilities and 12 buildings received assistance /were rehabilitated through the CDBG program in the past five years.
- CDBG-R created or retained 17.5 jobs in the past five years.
- CDBG funds in the amount of \$300,947 were spent on economic development activities such a direct financial assistance to businesses, commercial and industrial improvements, among others including Women's Economic Ventures.
- CDBG funds in the amount of \$1,619,677 were spent on public improvements, such as the development and improvements of public facilities, street and sidewalk improvements, water and sewer improvements, senior centers and child care facilities, and the development of parks and recreational facilities, among others. CDBG-R funds in the amount of \$118,615 were spent.
- CDBG funds in the amount of \$654,519 were spent on public services, such as services for senior and youth projects, health services, employment training, services for abused and neglected children, and services for the disabled, among others.
- CDBG funds in the amount of \$3,430,067 were provided for housing activities, such as construction, rehabilitation, homebuyer assistance, lead-based paint testing and abatement, among others.
