CDBG ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR THE PAST FIVE YEARS**

FACT SHEET

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)

- 2,152 persons benefitted from public services assisted through the CDBG program.
- 304 households received housing assistance through the CDBG program. Funded activity includes acquisition of vacant property that is developed into affordable housing.
- CDBG funds in the amount of \$2,586,263 were provided for housing activities, such as reconstruction, rehabilitation, homebuyer assistance, among others.
- CDBG funds in the amount of \$2,322,476 were spent on public improvements, such as street and sidewalk improvements, and the development of parks and recreational facilities, among others. Funded activity included paving of 22 blocks of streets in very low income neighborhoods.
- CDBG funds in the amount of \$512,454 were spent on public services, such as services for the elderly and disabled persons, and on child care for working parents.
- CDBG funds in the amount of \$327,172 were spent on activity aimed at eliminating or preventing slum and blight. Funded activity included demolition of 58 dilapidated structures.
