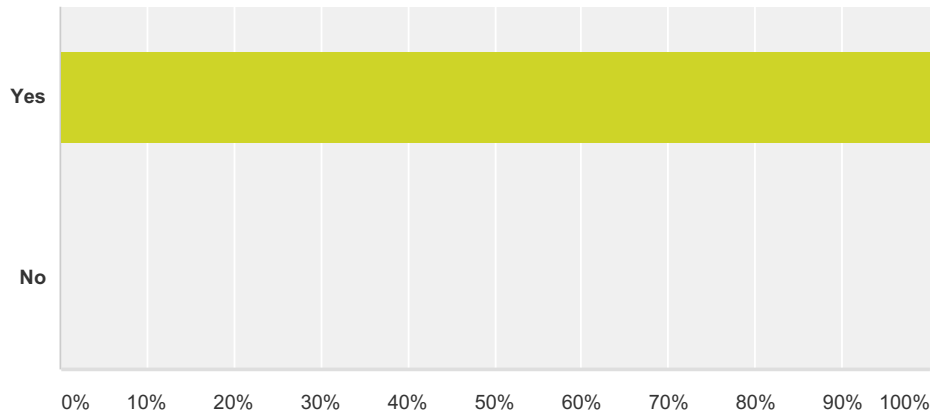

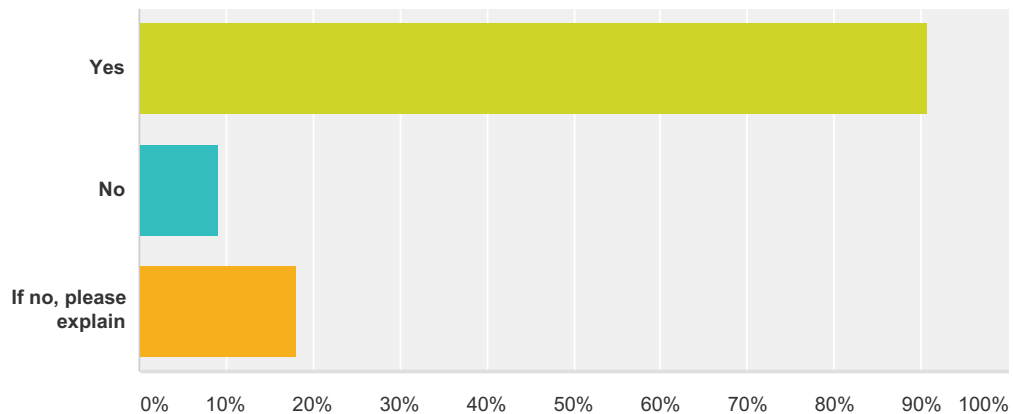

Q12 Did you like the food choices provided at the conference?

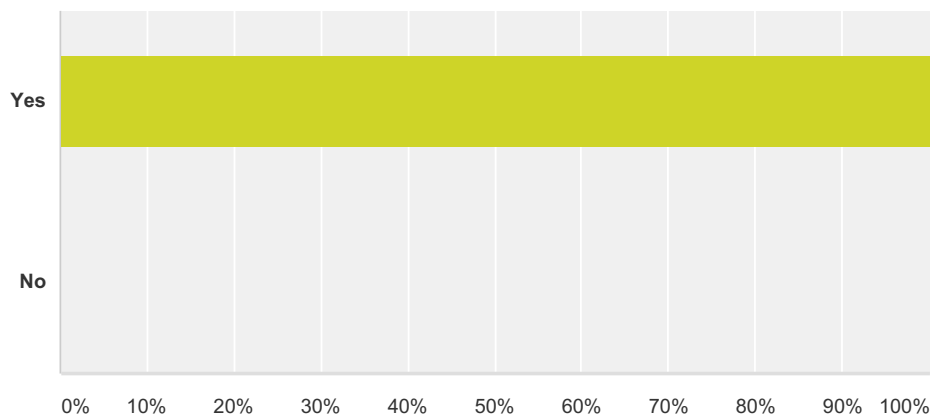

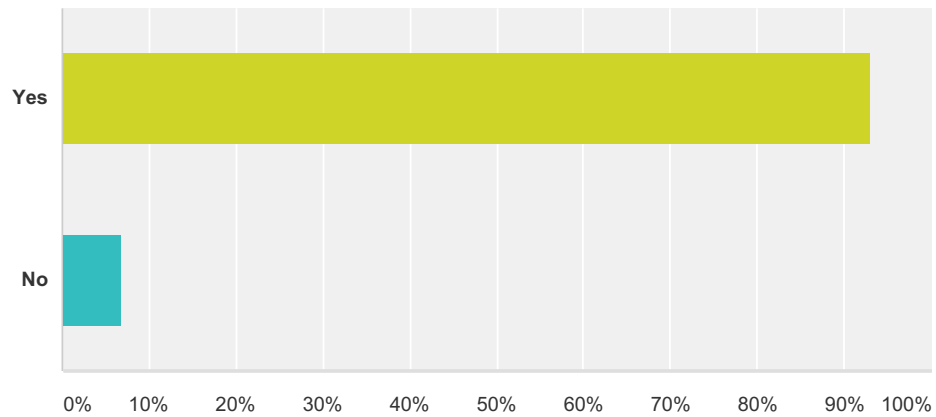

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Q14 Did you like the offering of the AICP CM Credit?

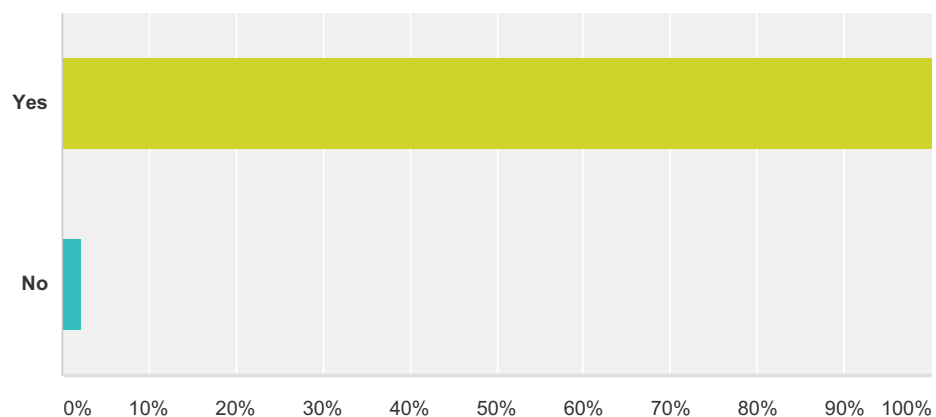
