Located in the Liberty City neighborhood, the site consists of two continuous parcels, @ 11 acres of land next to the Miami-Dade Water Treatment Plants and just east of the area's high school, Miami Northwestern Senior High.

Development History

- Formerly the site of a 50-year-old housing project (Knight Manor) that was torn down due to decay
- Land purchased by the City of Miami in the mid-1990s for \$725,000
- City Commission conveys land to the Urban League of Greater Miami (ULGM) shortly afterwards
- ULGM had difficulties securing private partner and additional funding
- Project stalled for several years
- City awards HOME funds in Aug. 2012 but had to deobligate in Feb. 2014 as project could not move forward due to funding issue
- Land appraises at \$4,050,000 in Oct. 2014

Development History 2

- City approves \$2 million in HOME funding (again) in July 2014
- Ground breaking in March 2015
- Certificate of Occupancy in April and Nov. 2017
- Two more phases planned for the future once funding is identified

Project Description

The Villages Miami consists of:

- Two residential buildings
- Stand alone, one-story Community Center
- Surface parking

The property's amenities include:

- Children's playground
- Dedicated room serving as parent resource center
- Secure, gated card-access entrance
- picnic area


